



Rostered Chief Umpire

Rostered Chief Umpire requirements include:

- Does not have to be accredited, but should have experience umpiring and have a basic knowledge of the rules.
- Hi Visibility Vest supplied by Thornlie & Districts
- Enclosed Shoes.
- Need to be approachable to answer questions if required.

Rostered Chief Umpire duties include:

- Attend to all diamonds periodically.
- Chief Umpire is a mediator, third party.
- Advise on procedures. i.e. Umpire Disputes.
- Advise of safety issues.
- Advise teams, players, parents, etc. of General Ground Rules, By-Laws and Code of Conduct that they must adhere too.
i.e. playing siren to siren, cabana use, players and helpers attire, smoking areas, etc..

Rostered Chief Umpire duties do not include:

- Over ruling decisions of Umpires.
- Umpires have final say, Not Chief Umpire.
- Rostered chief umpire is not there to tell other umpires what they are doing is wrong.
- Chief Umpire is not to enter diamonds, unless invited too.

**Association Chief Umpire is there to assist and advise umpires.
